# Guidelines for submission

This competition is open to all residents in the UK. The poem must be submitted in the English language and be original. No competition entries will be returned, the judge's decision is final and no correspondence can be entered into.

**Theme:** Games.

**Length:** No more than 50 lines per poem.

**Submission deadline:** Saturday 3rd September 2011.

**Submission fee adults:** £5 (junior category under 16 free).

Cheques payable to West Lancashire Borough Council or WLBC.

**Format:** The poem must be typed using Times New Roman, font size 12pt and single-spaced.

**Application Form:** A completed application form must be attached to the poem and submitted by post and
